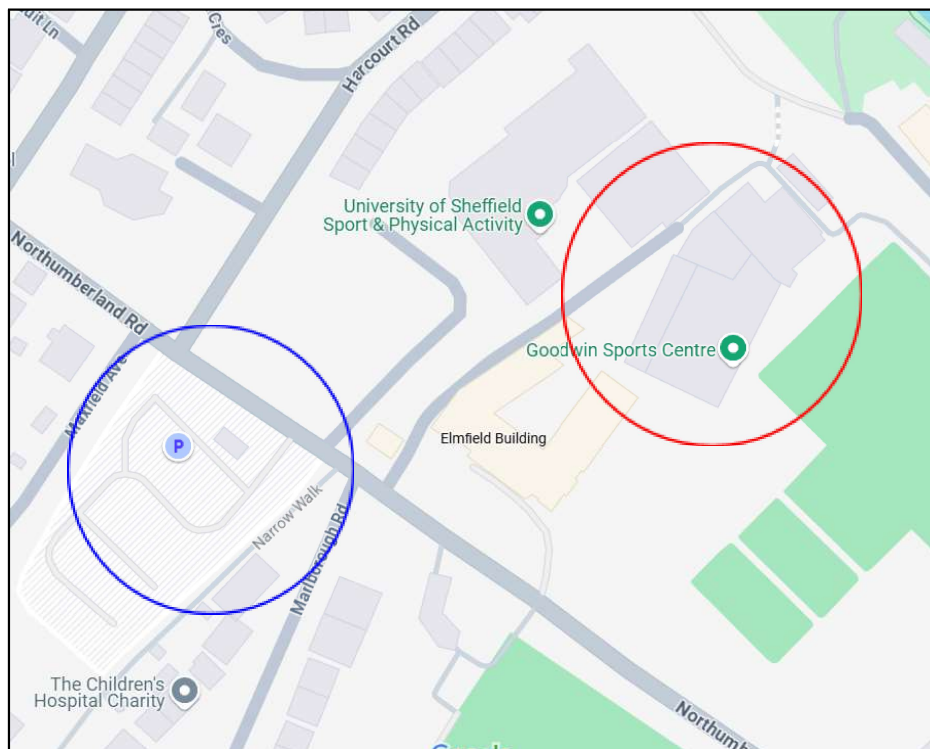


BUCS 2025 Accommodation and Evening Meal Final Details

Accommodation

Accommodation will be £25 per person and held at 3 Scout Huts across Sheffield: Woodseats Explorers, 142nd (Fulwood) and 36th (Ranmoor St John's). None of the huts have beds so roll mats and sleeping bags, or some similar arrangement will be needed. Some of the huts do have limited showering facilities, but we also have access to the showers at Goodwin Sports Centre so we would recommend heading to those in between the Individual event and heading to your accommodation. All the huts also have good public transport access to the meal that are provided below. They all also have free on street parking around the huts that can be used for cars and minibuses. We only have access to Woodseats from 5pm but by the time the event at Birchen edge has finished and you have used the showers at Goodwin this shouldn't be too long of a wait. Ranmoor and Fulwood we have access to all afternoon, specific details for getting into each hut will be discussed in the captains chat closer to the time. All 3 huts must be vacated and left in the same condition as when you arrived by 10am on the Sunday morning.

Parking for Goodwin Sports Centre is limited but there is on street parking available on the roads around it and we are trying to sort parking at a separate university car park on the same road. As soon as we get the go ahead for that we will let the captains chat know. The showers are located in the building in the red circle on the map. You should be able to head straight in and follow the signs to the showers without speaking to anyone at the desk. If we are able to sort parking in the university car park it will be located in the modular village car park circled in blue. Please can any universities staying in Woodseats try and wait until as close to 4 as possible to use the showers, just so we don't have everyone rocking up at once.

Evening Meal and Night Out

The evening meal will take place at Trafalgar Warehouse in Sheffield City Centre. Food will be provided by a selection of street food vans and there is a fully licensed bar at the venue, all to be paid for on the night. If you have any allergies or dietary requirements make this aware to the food vendors before you order. Entry is from 7pm with food being served from 7:30pm.

We have exclusive access to the venue until 11:30pm but after the beer race at around 10:30ish we will likely head out to a few bars on West Street. The night will then culminate at the Student Union's club The Foundry and the legendary Poptarts. We have our own private ticket to buy tickets linked below. You must have a student ID to gain entry to Poptarts but 2 non-students can accompany each student so any alumni competing over the weekend will still be able to attend. If you are not a University of Sheffield student you will need to create a guest account before you can buy tickets, the link for that is also below.
